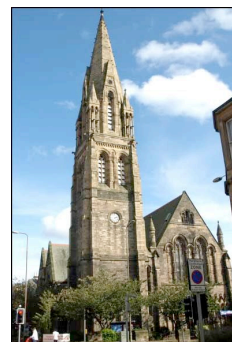


CRAIGMILLAR CONSERVATION AREA LISTED BUILDINGS

[MAYFIELD ROAD AND WEST MAYFIELD](#), MAYFIELD SALISBURY CHURCH, INCLUDING CHURCH HALL, GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 27119) - Category B building listed on 14/12/1970. Hippolyte J Blanc, 1876 1879 with later spire 1894 and 20th century extensions. Cruciform-plan, French Gothic church; 4 stage square plan tower with octagonal spire to NE, dominant nave with low side aisles, M gabled transepts, clerestory, polygonal apse and church hall adjoining to S.



[18 WEST MAYFIELD](#), FORMER MANSE TO MAYFIELD SALISBURY CHURCH, INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS, GATEPIER AND PEDESTRIAN GATE (Ref: 44439) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. Hippolyte J Blanc, 1876 with modern alterations. 2 storey and basement, 3 bay asymmetrical Gothic style house with single storey wing adjoining to E.



[20 AND 20A WEST MAYFIELD](#), MAYFIELD HOUSE INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS, GATEPIERS AND PEDESTRIAN GATES (Ref: 44440) - Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Circa 1870. 2 storey, 3 bay symmetrical classical house; single storey wing adjoining to E.



[21 WEST MAYFIELD](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44441) Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Circa 1870 with 20th century alterations. 2 storey, 3 bay symmetrical classical house with single storey wings adjoining to N and S.



[10 MAYFIELD GARDENS](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref:44225) Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Circa 1870 with modern additions. 2 storey and basement, 3 bay house with classical details on corner site; modern garage and restaurant extension adjoining house to S.



[2-28 \(EVEN NOS\) MOSTON TERRACE](#) AND 13 BRIGHT'S CRESCENT, INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS AND PEDESTRIAN GATE (Ref: 44248) - Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Circa 1880. 2 storey and attic, 29 bay, near symmetrical terrace of houses with eclectic details.



[48-54 \(EVEN NOS\) MAYFIELD ROAD](#) (Ref: 30451) Category C building listed on 15/01/1992. Circa 1877. Terrace of 2 2-storey villas, designed on a theme.



[WEST SAVILE ROAD AND CRAIGMILLAR PARK](#), ROYAL BLIND SCHOOL, INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS AND GATE LODGE (Ref: 44443) - Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Charles Leadbetter, 1874; 20th century additions and alterations.



[CRAIGMILLAR PARK, CRAIGMILLAR PARK CHURCH INCLUDING WAR MEMORIAL, GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS](#) (Ref: 44210) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. Hardy and Wight, 1878; church hall, 1899. Cruciform-plan, Gothic church with hall adjoining to N.

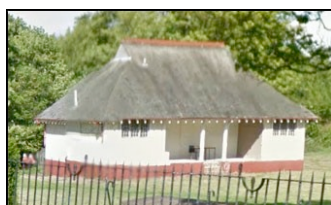
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[6, 6A, 6B AND 8 CRAIGMILLAR PARK](#), BELMONT HOUSE, INCLUDING GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44207) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. Circa 1885. 2 storey, 3 bay near symmetrical classical house.



[17-21 \(ODD NOS\) CRAWFURD ROAD](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44211) Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century. 2 storey and attic, 7 bay near symmetrical, classical terrace of 3 houses.



[FORMER CLUB HOUSE, CRAWFURD ROAD](#), EDINBURGH (Ref: 47605) - Category C building and was listed on 16/02/2001. Alexander Lorne Campbell, 1895; additions and alterations, RD Cameron & Gibb, 1980. Single storey, 5-bay, rectangular- plan, Arts and Crafts style former sports pavilion to N of recreation ground; with steeply-pitched gambrel roof.



[EAST SUFFOLK ROAD](#), ST MARGARET'S SCHOOL (FORMER CRAIGMILLAR PARK FREE CHURCH), INCLUDING GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44214) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. Cruciform-plan, Perpendicular Gothic church now in use as school; 2 stage incomplete tower to NW; dominant nave with low side aisles, polygonal apse, shallow transepts; single storey octagonal church hall adjoining to N.



[6 EAST SUFFOLK ROAD](#) (LODGE) AND 1-13 (INCLUSIVE NUMBERS) AND 20-22 (INCLUSIVE NUMBERS) EAST SUFFOLK PARK, GATEPIERS, BOUNDARY WALLS AND RAILINGS (Ref: 30050) - Category B building listed on 12/12/1974. A K Robertson, 1914; completed (eastern ranges) to Robertson's design by Frank Wood in 1925. Symmetrically arranged group of 5 Arts and Crafts residence blocks, sited around rectangular garden.



[19 CRAIGMILLAR PARK](#), INCLUDING GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44208) Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century with 1996 addition. 3 bay symmetrical Continental style house with central 3 stage tower and advanced flanking 2 storey blocks.



[7 AND 8 GILMOUR ROAD](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44216) Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century. 2 storey, 4 bay symmetrical pair of classical houses.



[18 WEST SAVILE ROAD](#), TARQUIN HOUSE, INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS AND RAILINGS (Ref: 44442) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. Later 19th century. 2-storey asymmetrical 3- bay house with circular entrance tower.



[7 AND 9 GRANBY ROAD](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44221) Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century. 2 storey, 4 bay symmetrical

[8 AND 10 GRANBY ROAD](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44222)

Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century. 2 storey 4 bay symmetrical pair of houses with classical details.



[50, 50A AND 52 CRAIGMILLAR PARK](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44209)

Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century. 2 storey and attic, 4 bay asymmetrical house with baronial and classical detailing.



[10 AND 12 LYGON ROAD](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44224)

Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century; modern garage adjoining to E. 2 storey and attic, 4 bay pair of symmetrical houses with baronial detailing.



[1-5 \(INCLUSIVE NOS\) GORDON TERRACE](#), INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44217)

Category C building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century. 2 storey and attic, 12 bay asymmetrical terrace with baronial detailing.



[9 GORDON TERRACE](#), NETHERBRAE, INCLUDING GATEPIERS, BOUNDARY WALLS AND GARAGE (Ref: 44218) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. W N Thomson of Leith, 1897. 2-storey nearly rectangular-plan freestyle house.



[10 AND 10A GORDON TERRACE](#), CADEMUIR, INCLUDING GATES, GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44219) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. W N Thomson of Leith, 1901. 2-storey irregular plan freestyle house with classical details.



[11 GORDON TERRACE](#), SOUTH PARK, INCLUDING GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44220) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. Late 19th century. 2 storey and attic, 3 bay house with classical details; 3 stage, central entrance tower.



[169 MAYFIELD ROAD](#) AND 43 ESLEMONT ROAD, INCLUDING BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44226) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. H E Clifford, 1911. 2-storey and attic, 3-bay rectangular-plan house.



[21 HALLHEAD ROAD](#), RANKINE HOUSE, INCLUDING GATES, GATEPIERS AND BOUNDARY WALLS (Ref: 44223) - Category B building listed on 25/03/1997. Arthur Balfour Paul, 1923. 2-storey near T- plan Arts and Crafts house.
